The **DIT Choral Society** perform a festive favourite, 'Oratorio de Noël' by Saint-Saens, along with two Vespers by Rachmaninoff in the beautiful surroundings of St Ann's Church. Conducted by Simon Harden, the choir comprises over 40 singers from DIT Conservatory of Music and Drama, and will be accompanied by the DIT Symphony Orchestra and soloists.

The **DIT Chamber Choir** perform seasonal music through the ages, along with a number of Christmas carol favourites. The DIT Chamber Choir is a vocal ensemble of DIT Conservatory of Music and Drama. As well as giving concerts, the choir participates in competitions, twice winning first prize in the national chamber choir competition at the Cork International Choral Festival, alongside other prizes for individual pieces. Under the direction of conductor Bernie Sherlock the choir has won the Feis Ceoil Culwick Cup for chamber choir on seven occasions and released its first CD -- *Carols for Christmas*. In the 2016 ESB Feis Ceoil, the DIT Chamber Choir was awarded the Clef Club Award, the Culwick Cup and the Oliver O'Brien prize for the best overall adult choir.
